

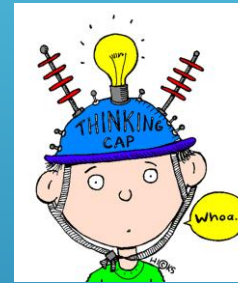
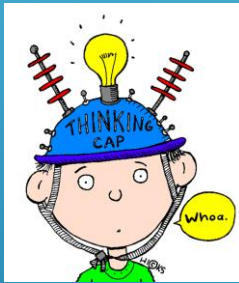
MCPS GIFTED & TALENTED PROGRAM

Grades K-2

IDENTIFICATION

GT specialist provides enrichment lessons to all K-2 students to look for gifted characteristics.



Students demonstrating gifted characteristics are referred to be tested for eligibility to receive GT services.

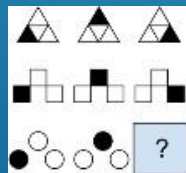
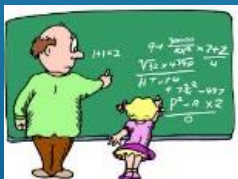


IDENTIFICATION (CONT.)

All 2nd grade students are given the Naglieri Nonverbal Abilities test to screen for advanced intellectual aptitude.

Students may also be referred by teachers, parents, and/or themselves.

Identified K-2 students are currently eligible for General Intellectual Aptitude Services (2+ years above grade level ability must be demonstrated in both language & math).



SERVICES

PLACEMENT



Identified GT students are placed together within a general education classroom.

PUSH-IN



GT specialist teaches whole class enrichment lessons in classrooms 4-5 times per year.

PULL-OUT



Identified GT students are provided with enrichment classes with the GT specialist 1 hour per week.
